

Chariton Community Schools Facility Plan

The Chariton Community School District developed the following list of projects in conjunction with 10 Fold, an architectural firm hired by the district. This list of projects and facility updates was then vetted by a committee of administrators, teachers, school board members, community members, and the 10 Fold staff.

Projects that have been completed

- Reynolds Field Complex and Bob Cain Track
 - Synthetic turf project
 - Track field event area upgrade
 - Press Box painting project
 - Track surface repainted
- HVAC system to air condition the kitchen and multi-purpose room - Columbus
- HVAC system to air condition the kitchen and multi-purpose room - Van Allen
- New playground and sidewalk project - Van Allen

Projects currently in the planning or construction stage

PPEL/ SAVE funded project

- Middle School
 - Stormwater Mitigation Project
 - \$599,642.00 from Joiner Construction
- Exterior walk-in door replacement - Central Office / Bus barn

ESSER funded projects

- Van Allen and Columbus Elementary Window Replacement
 - Windows: 8-10 weeks
 - Storefront Glazing/Doors: 6-8 weeks
 - Cost: \$410K +/-
 - Construction: Summer of 2024
- High School HVAC Controls Replacement
 - Cost: \$175K - \$250K
 - Construction: Summer of 2024
- High School Science Classroom Renovations
 - Estimate Construction Cost: \$700K - \$800K
 - Construction: Summer of 2024

Homeland Security grant project

- All buildings - Safety and Security Improvements
 - When a grant is approved, start work when possible
 - Complete by the end of the school year, May 2024

The following bulleted items are only part of the identified projects from the facility study performed by the school district; this list of projects have been prioritized through the committee's vetting process. The CCSD School Board is now prioritizing them further and creating a timeline and funding source for completion. The facility plan is a long-range plan that will be revisited annually and will continue to evolve to meet the district and student's needs.

Projects prioritized by the facility committee to be considered to complete

- Auditorium renovation (Pit cover, theatrical rigging equipment, improved access to the control booth, updated A/V technology, and updated finishes in the house and stage)
- Classroom technology- all buildings
- Sewer smell - HS
- Exit and emergency lighting upgrades
- Settlement issue at Van Allen
- Vent hood improvements at Van Allen
- Stormwater and grading improvements - Van Allen and Columbus
- A new secure and welcome entry - Van Allen and Columbus
- Water line improvements - HS
- Industrial Arts/CTE/AG upgrades and improvements
- Replacement of doors - bus facility
- Tennis Court Improvements - Work with City
- South parking improvements - Reynolds Field
- Maintenance building improvement and addition
- Interior cosmetic repairs and improvements - MS
- Phase 2 exterior settlement mitigation -MS
- HVAC control improvements - Columbus and Van Allen
