

Injury or Illness at School

When a student becomes ill or is injured at school, the school district will attempt to notify the student's parents as soon as possible.

The school district, while not responsible for medical treatment of an ill or injured student, will have employees present to administer emergency or minor first aid if possible. An ill or injured child will be turned over to the care of the parents or qualified medical employees as quickly as possible. If an emergency exists and the parent or alternate cannot be reached, the student will be transported to the local hospital by ambulance. Only a doctor is qualified to make a medical diagnosis. If the nurse or other school official has reason to suspect a serious health problem, the parents will be notified with the suggestion that the student see a doctor immediately.
